Roots of Empathy

This year our senior class students are following the Roots of Empathy programme. The children learn emotional literacy over 27 lessons. Every third lesson Baby Nell and her mom Lorraine visit the class for a Family Visit Lesson. By observing a secure attachment relationship between baby and parent, children see a model of empathy. The baby and their relationship with their parent then act as a vehicle to introduce the language of emotional literacy. There is extensive research showing that children who participate in the programme show an increase in empathy, an increase in prosocial behaviours e.g. sharing, helping and including and a decrease in aggressive behaviours including bullying.

- Introduce structured journaling practices for all pupils to encourage self-reflection, problem-solving strategies
